### **Important Program Change!**

This program partially closed as of the end of the day July 31, 2014, but applications will still be accepted for Tennessee homeowners who are having difficulty paying their mortgage due to either a **long-term medical disability OR to being in the military**.

Your file has been forwarded to our agency for processing of your application to participate in the Hardest Hit Fund. We look forward to working with you and it is our most sincere desire to assist you in qualifying for this program.

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You have already taken the first step by going online and registering. The next step is to schedule an appointment to meet with a counselor in our office to do your official application for the program. Prior to scheduling your appointment there is a list of items that you will need to gather and bring with you. That list is attached and these items are critical to the processing of your loan and are required documentation. It is important that you have all of these when you arrive for your appointment. If you have any questions or need assistance please call us and let us know ahead of time.

Once you have your items we will schedule your intake appointment. Once we have all the required documentation we will submit your application for approval to THDA. Our office does not approve your loan. This is done by Tennessee Housing Development Agency under the direction of the Department of the Treasury. We estimate that the approval process will take a minimum of 30 days however this estimate can change based on many things.

We congratulate you for taking the initiative to pursue all options available in your effort to keep your home. We are here to support you in that quest. Let us know if you have any questions at this time.

Read through the enclosed requirements to make sure you meet the qualifications. Please call our office at 615-251-0025 and speak with the receptionist to make an appointment with a counselor <u>AFTER</u> you have gathered <u>ALL</u> the required documentation on the enclosed list. Bring COPIES of all documents with you to your appointment.

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## TENNESSEE'S HARDEST HIT FUND

## Providing Mortgage Payments to Keep Families in Their Homes



The Hardest Hit Fund is a mortgage assistance program for Tennessee's <u>disabled homeowners</u> offered by the NeighborWorks Alliance of Tennessee as partners of Tennessee Housing Development Agency.

#### To qualify, a homeowner must:

- Be struggling to pay their mortgage due to disability.
- Have lost at least 30% of their income due to disability.
- The purchase of the home must be prior to receiving the disability.
- Have first mortgage loan balance on residence less than or equal to \$275,000.
- Have current gross household income less than or equal to \$92,680.
- Have no more than six months of reserves to pay mortgage principle, interest, taxes and insurance.

#### How much assistance is available?

• **STATEWIDE** – Unemployed or underemployed homeowners in <u>all Tennessee counties</u> are eligible to apply for forgivable loans up to \$40,000 to cover up to 36 months of mortgage expenses.

#### Will the homeowner have to pay back Hardest Hit Fund assistance?

- This is a 0% interest, forgivable, non-recourse, deferred-payment, subordinate loan. A forgiveness clause
  will reduce the loan amount by 20% a year for every year the borrower stays in the home. At the end of
  five years the note will be considered satisfied and THDA will release the lien securing the note.
- All deferred, subordinate mortgages will be evidenced by a Home Equity Line of Credit promissory note
  and secured by a deed of trust on the property. Borrowers will be required to sign and acknowledge via
  written agreement indicating the program guidelines.
- Loan funds are due and payable if before five years the property is sold, refinanced or no longer owner occupied and there are sufficient equity proceeds available.

Continue to follow TN-12 N/Rosa L Parks Blvd/US-41A N. Turn right onto Vantage Way. 50 Vantage Way will be on the left.
